Rules

Daily Grade

Class work: must be turned in before leaving class.

(outlines, vocabulary, review questions, handouts, etc...)

Lab/Project Sheet: practical/participation/sanitation duties

Manikins, customers (2nd & 3rd year students), each other (personal services), and projects assigned by instructor

Bell work: to be completed the first <u>five</u> minutes of class.

Students who fail a test will have the opportunity to re-test (this will be done before school: 6:30 a.m.: This applies to failing students only.

Materials Required Daily

- 1. Textbook, Notebook (paper, pens & pencils), and Workbook (s).
- 2. Practical Sheet AND Time Card Folder
- Cosmetology kit (manikins, smock, etc...)-DO NOT take home any items in kit!

If you do not have these items each day points will be deducted!!!!

Maintaining Notebooks

Each student should maintain a three-ring binder (minimum 3") with all notes, handouts, daily assignments, etc... Notebook quiz grade may be given at any time.

Time Card:

Turn in every Friday. Five points will be deducted for each school day it is late, and will not be accepted over one week late. (See handout on time card procedures)

Make Up Work (Attendance is very important for this class)

Make up work will be given to students who have an **excused** absence. You are responsible for any work that you may have missed during an absence. Please complete work as soon as you return to school, so you will not be too far behind the other students. Work, tests, etc... not made up will receive a zero. Make up tests/quizzes, etc..., are given before school: 6:30 a.m.

Lab days are mandatory and can't be made up.

Late Work

Late work will not receive full credit.

Progress Report

Progress reports will be given to each student at least once per nine weeks. Students should check Power School periodically for their updated grades.
